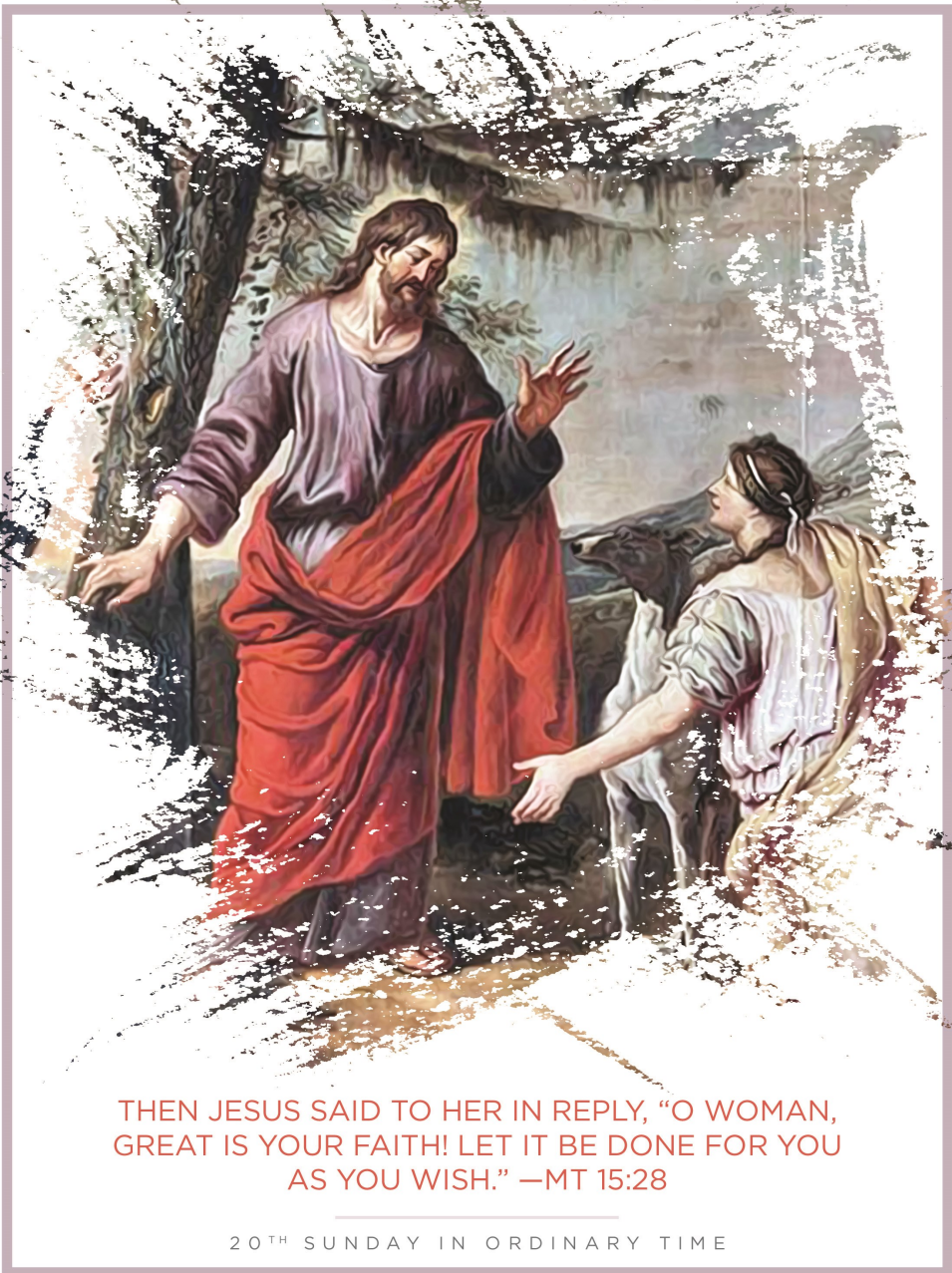

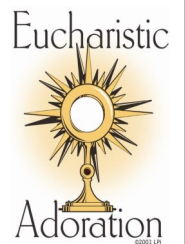

Reflections from Father John

According to the *Catechism of the Catholic Church*, Christian hope is “the theological virtue by which we desire the kingdom of heaven and eternal life as our happiness, placing our trust in Christ’s promises and relying not on our own strength, but on the help of the grace of the Holy Spirit”. (CCC 1817).

This statement is chock full of ideas important to every Catholic. A theological virtue means: it is gift granted by God to all who will accept that gift. Those who will not accept that gift risk falling into sin, the sin of despair. Despair is the complete loss or absence of hope. It is a sin because when we fall into despair, we succumb to not looking towards the promise of eternal life. Without the Kingdom of heaven, we are nothing! There can be no happiness without hope, do you see the connection I’m making here?

Christ made us promises; if we fulfill what Jesus asks of us, we will receive the rewards He promised. We must trust Christ, not looking to our own stubborn human nature, but relying on everything Jesus said. The question becomes, how do we do that in the face of adversity or suffering? It is the help of the Holy Spirit that allows us the perseverance or patience to maintain our hope. This is our ace-in-the-hole, the power of the Holy Spirit. With His aid, we never lose hope. If you are facing any issues in life, rely on the grace of the Eucharist and the power of Holy Spirit to sustain you in hope; and you will never despair.
