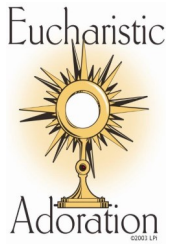

### Parish Bus Trip

Plan to join us for a Christmas-themed parish bus trip on Tuesday, December 5, 2023. We'll depart from Celestine at 10:15 a.m. for the Derby Dinner Playhouse in Clarksville where we will have a noon meal before enjoying the play **A Christmas Carol: The Musical**. This musical version is a 21<sup>st</sup> Century rendition of the classic tale of Ebenezer Scrooge. (Three other matinee performances of this musical during the same week are already sold out!)

Our second destination will be the **Mega Cavern's Lights under Louisville**, the only underground holiday light show in the world. We will remain on the bus and slowly proceed through the cavern, listening to holiday music as we view the many displays which are composed of more than six million points of light. As we begin our homeward trip, we will make a stop at **Huber's Orchard and Winery** in Starlight.

The cost of this, our 16<sup>th</sup> St. Isidore parish bus trip, will be \$100. Of this amount, \$50 is non-refundable but transferable. 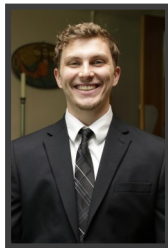
