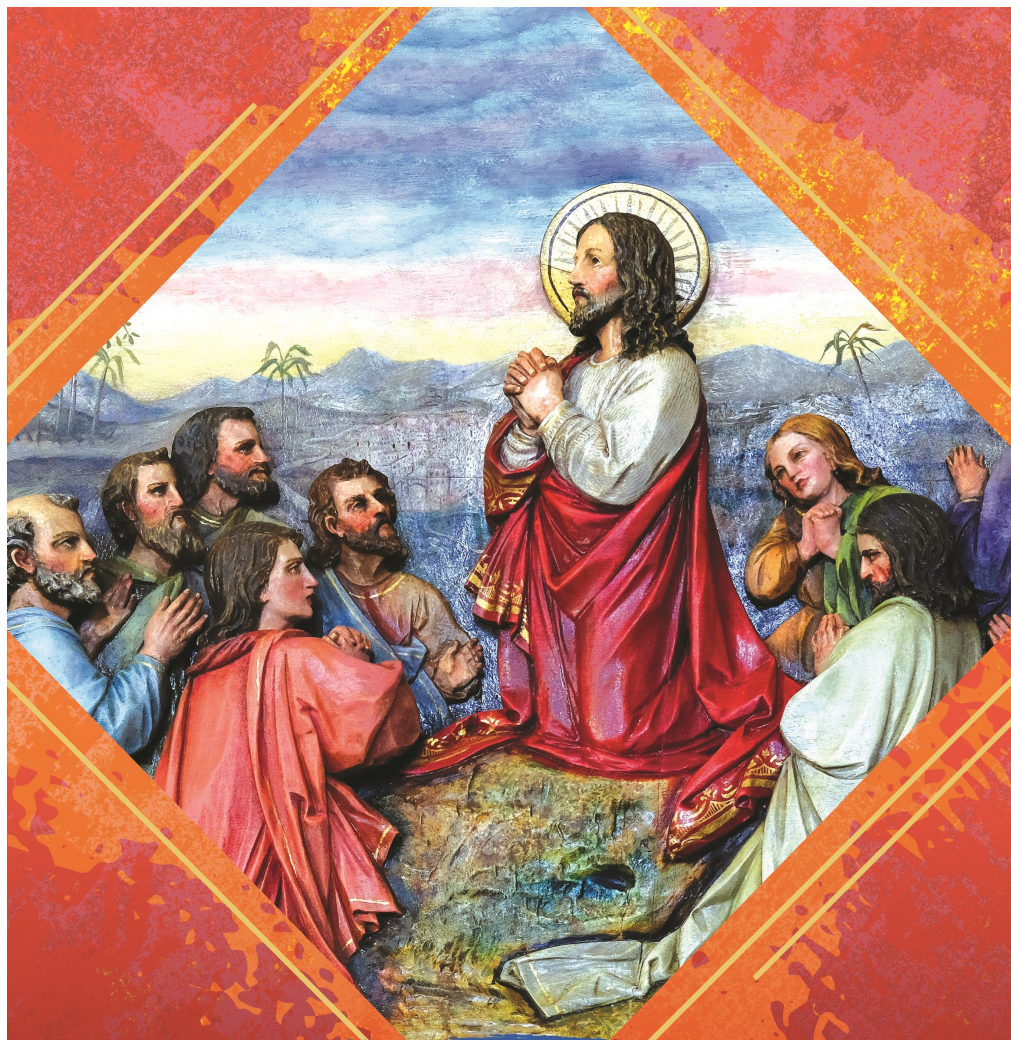



Each night is different and run by the camp staff. The evening program is very engaging at every age and challenges those present to deepen their faith.

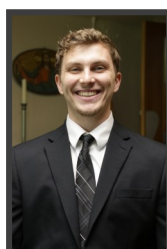
