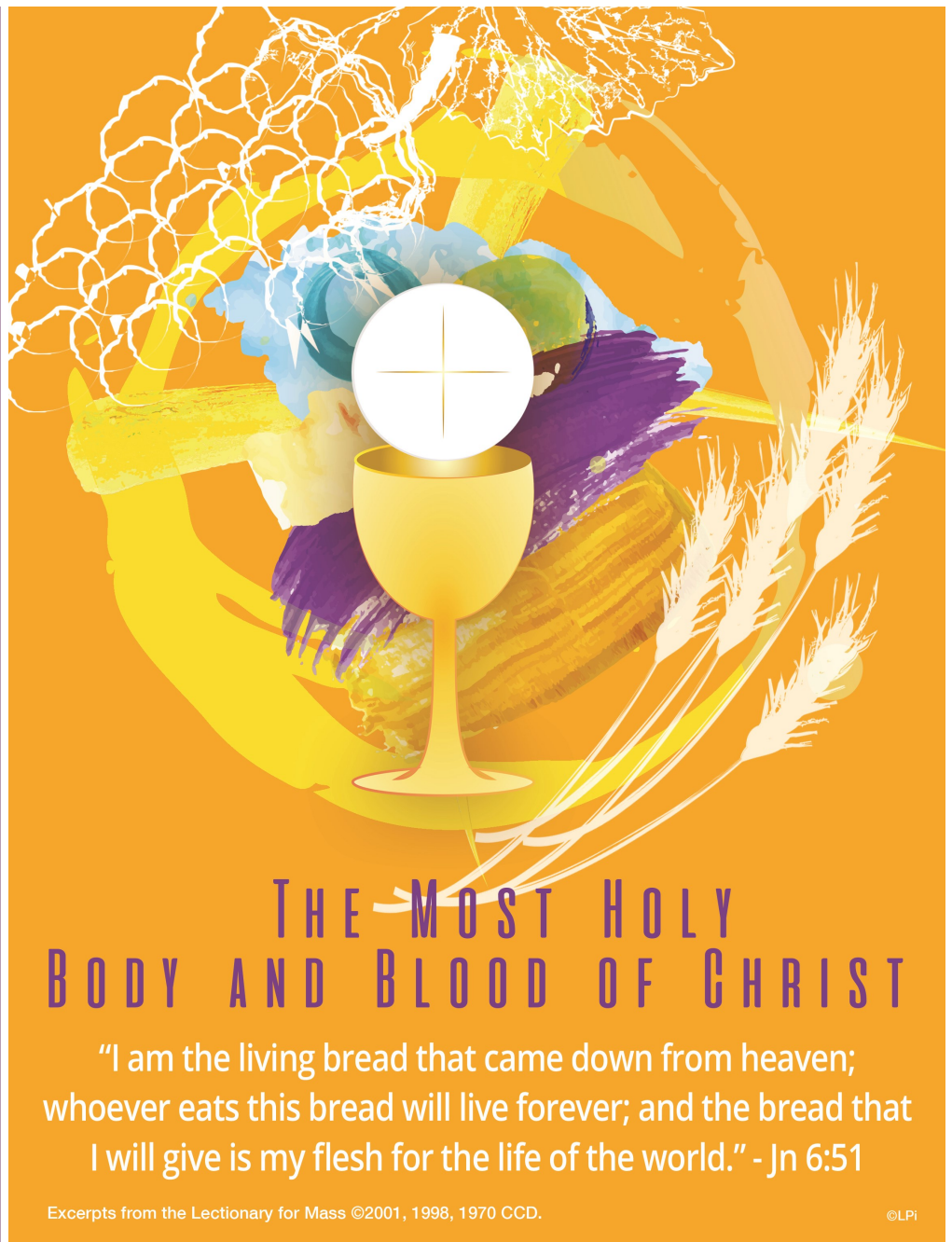

## St. Isidore Bus Trip

The St. Isidore Bus trip was a rousing success and a good time was had by all! With visits to the Cathedral of the Basilica, Covington, Kentucky and Old St. Mary's Church in Cincinnati's historic Over-The-Rhine neighborhood, it is no wonder the rider's faith was stirred. Participants from Celestine, Dubois, Schnellville, Jasper, Ferdinand, St. Anthony, Mariah Hill, and other places were greatly moved by the beauty of Catholicity and the fellowship between churches. Other stops included the Krohn Conservatory Butterfly exhibit, and the popular German Hofbrauhaus for accordion serenading and the tapping of the keg ceremony, and Jungle Jim's shopping experience, each stop adding further excitement to the trip. Exploring the huge National Underground Railroad Freedom Center was a profound and powerful study of the dark history of slavery in America and the uplifting fight of Abolitionists to free individuals. Many thanks to our own Clara Fromme and Dorothy Rasche who organized and led the expedition.
