

Parish Bus Trip

Plan to join us for a Christmas-themed parish bus trip on Tuesday, December 5, 2023. This musical version is a 21st Century rendition of the classic tale of Ebenezer Scrooge. (Three other matinee performances of this musical during the same week are already sold out!)




