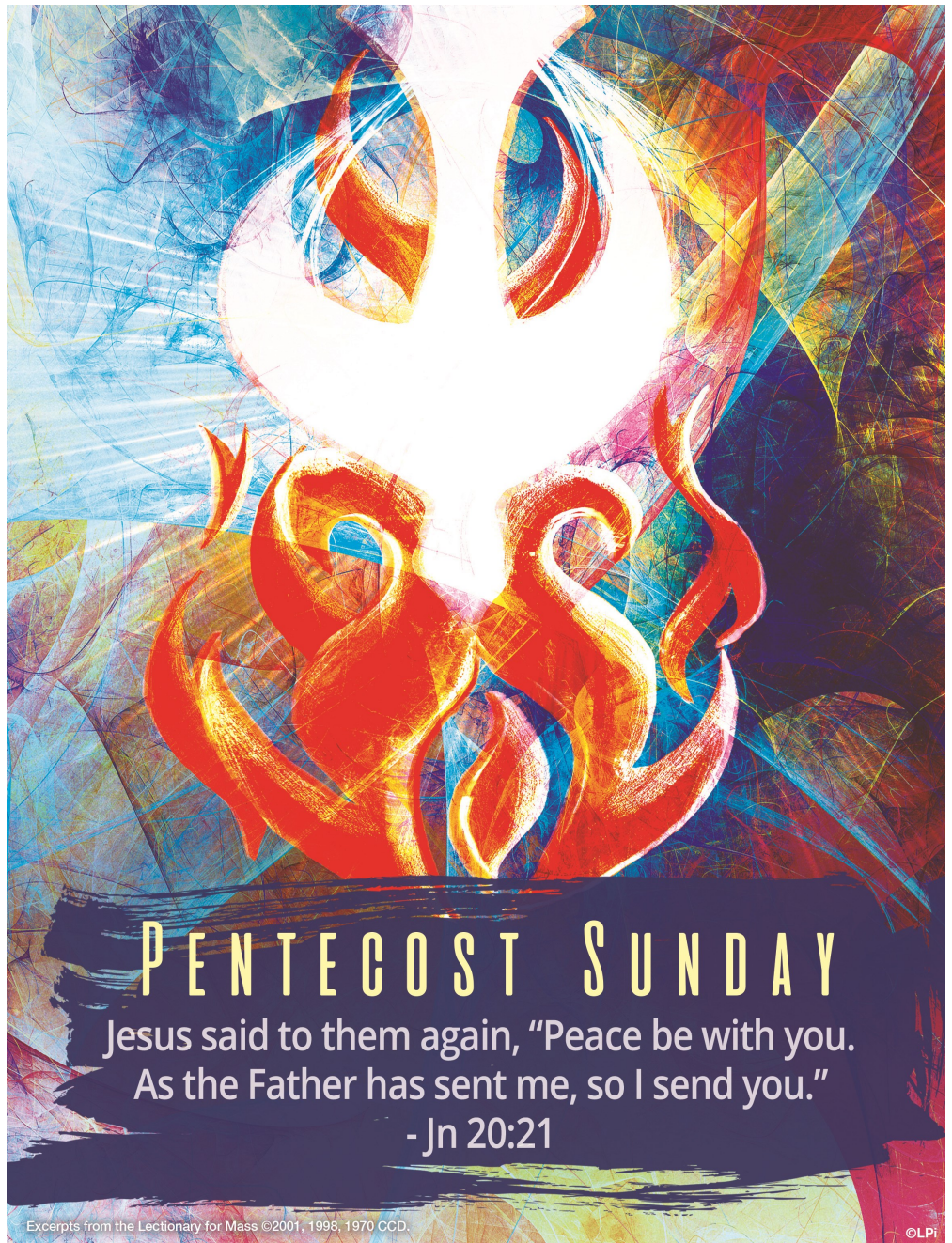

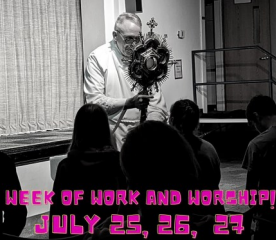


Rosary Trail

Southwest Indiana Patriot Guard Ride to Remember is a tour of cemeteries to honoring fallen service members at their gravesites. I was fortunate to attend with parishioners, members of the community, and with the grieving families. The servicemen graves we visited included:



The son of Glenn "Jake" and Melinda Lueken and the brother of Brent, Marine Corporal Eric Robert Lueken died in Iraq at the age of 23 on April 22, 2006.



The son of Gerald and Leona Moore and the father of Rylee Weisheit, Indiana Army National Guard Sargent First Class David L. Moore served in Bosnia, Iraq, and in Louisiana during hurricane Katrina, dying at the age of 42 on February 4, 2008.



The son of Alan and Sandy Terwiske and the brother of Ashlee, Codi, and Brant, Marine Lance Corporal Alec Terwiske died in Afghanistan at the age of 21 on September 3, 2012.

- Can attend meetings once a month (second Thur.) for parish council and every other month (6 per year) for Religious Education Commission.

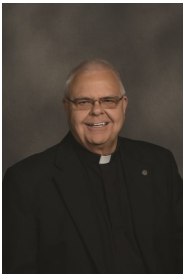
